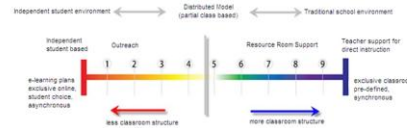

Free Online Workshops

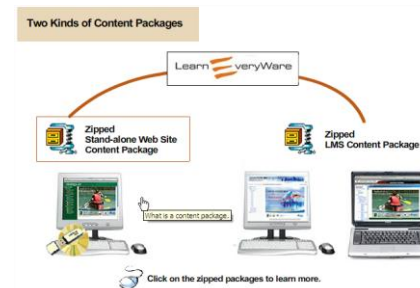
The first workshop, **An Introduction to Learn EveryWare Online Courses**, introduces the following topics:
